Taste of Duncanville Rules and Regulations

- Booth placement is on a first-come first-serve basis. While we will make every attempt to place you at one of your preferred locations, it is ultimately up to the placement committee.
- The Chamber encourages each vendor to coordinate and arrange its own prize drawings to help solicit attendees to visit your booth. Your winners can be contacted personally after the event.
- All exhibits must be set up between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Thursday, March 14th. It is very important to be set up by 3:30 p.m. at the latest for public safety.
- Exhibitors must not disassemble exhibits until 8 p.m. on Thursday, March 16th and must be out of the building no later than 9 p.m. It is very important to follow these guidelines due to public safety issues. You are responsible for the cleanup of your designated booth space.
